



# FIRE ACTION NOTICE

In the event of a FIRE	ACTION
<b>How people will be warned if there is a fire:</b>	Persons who first see the fire should raise the alarm to warn other persons in the property.
<b>If you find a fire:</b>	<p>Raise the alarm by shouting “Fire, Fire, Fire” to warn others.</p> <p>Call the fire brigade immediately on <b>999</b></p> <p>Do not put yourself at risk.</p> <p>Leave the building by the nearest available exit.</p> <p>Proceed to the assembly point and await further instructions.</p>
<b>Evacuation of the vulnerable/Are there disabled occupants</b>	Less able residents to stay in flat with all doors and windows closed until fire services arrive and can evacuate them. A list of flat numbers where those persons live is situated in the lobby (Please attach or notify GH Property Management). Fire services also made aware.
<b>Hearing alarm:</b>	<p>Evacuate the building by the nearest available escape route.</p> <p>If you have visitors with you, instruct them to follow you.</p> <p>Where possible close doors behind you, do not put yourself at risk or cause delay.</p>
<b>How the fire and rescue services and any other necessary services will be called and who will be responsible for doing this.</b>	The person discovering the fire will be responsible for calling the fire service.
